



American Express Company Semi-Annual Political Contributions Report January-June 2014

American Express participates in the political process through the American Express Company Political Action Committee (AXP PAC) and through corporate political contributions in those jurisdictions where it is permissible to do so. American Express does not spend corporate funds directly on electioneering communications, and AXP PAC does not contribute to presidential campaigns. American Express provides a semi-annual report to the public on all political contributions made through AXP PAC or corporate funds. The American Express Company Semi-Annual Political Contributions Report includes: contributions to political candidates, parties and committees; contributions to other political entities organized and operating under 26 U.S.C. Sec. 527 of the Internal Revenue Code; independent political expenditures; dues used for political purposes by trade associations, entities organized under section 501(c) 4 of the Code, and other tax exempt organizations (that receive in excess of \$50,000 during the calendar year from the Company); and payments made to influence the outcome of ballot measures. American Express Company Trade Associations and Memberships

American Express requests information regarding political contributions from trade associations, entities organized under section 501(c) 4 of the Code, and other tax exempt organizations of which American Express is a member that engage in non-deductible lobbying and political expenditures under Code section 162(e). For any such organization that receives in excess of \$50,000 during the calendar year from the Company, American Express requests that the organization identify the portion of American Express' payments used, if any, in connection with participation or intervention in a political campaign on behalf of (or in opposition to) any ballot initiative or candidate for public office, as defined under Subsection 162(e)(1)(B) of the Code. American Express includes in its political contributions report on our website any amounts reported to us that were used for such purposes.

In 2013, of the 11 trade associations that replied, no payments were used in connection with participation or intervention in a political campaign on behalf of (or in opposition to) any ballot initiative or candidate for public office, as defined under Subsection 162(e)(1)(B) of the Code.
